**Today's Operations:** Firefighters on the **Marble Valley and Gold Hill Fires** will continue the final stages of mop up, remove danger trees, patrol, and initiate suppression repair work where appropriate. Both fires are now estimated to be 96% contained.

**Weather and Fire Behavior:** The forecast for the area is for mostly cloudy skies with a continuing chance of light showers. Some sun will increase temperatures over yesterday. Fire activity will be limited today.

**Fire Information:** On September 1, 2015, management of the Marble Valley and Gold Hill Fires will transition back to the Washington State Department of Natural Resources, Northeast District. For future inquiries about these fires please call 509-684-7260.
