EFFECTIVE: AUGUST 3, 2009

OPEN FIRES are **NOT PERMITTED** in the backcountry until further notice due to the high fire danger. Fuel stoves are OK.

Fires are permitted in frontcountry campground metal grates with supervision.

Along the park's coastal strip, campfires are permitted below the high tide line on the beach. Exception- between *Wedding Rocks* and *Yellow Banks* where a year round fire ban is in effect.
