Fire Update – 08/16/2012 9:30a.m. PT

Mount Barney Fire, at the head of Falls Creek, is estimated to be about 40 acres.

The fire is under the command of the Methow Valley Ranger District. Monica Nicholson is the Incident Commander.

Firefighters have mopped up the main fire and spot fires. They will be demobbing from the fire today. The fire will be going into patrol status at the end of shift today.

This is the final update for the Mt. Barney Fire.
