When air quality is in this range **“Unhealthy for Sensitive Populations”** there is an increasing likelihood of adverse health effects for those with pre-existing heart and lung diseases. People with pre-existing heart and lung diseases, the elderly, and children should limit prolonged outdoor exertion

---

When the air quality is in the **“Unhealthy”** range there may be increased aggravation of pre-existing heart and lung diseases and premature mortality among sensitive populations. Increasing adverse respiratory effects may also be seen in the general population. People with pre-existing health conditions, the elderly, and children should avoid any prolonged exertion. Everyone else should limit prolonged exertion.

When the air quality is in the **“Hazardous”** range everyone should try to stay indoors and limit exertion. Everyone should limit time spent outdoors.
