Meeks Table Fire: 1500 & 1600 Roads Camp Retrieval Guidelines

Purpose: To allow the members of the public the opportunity to retrieve their camp gear, equipment, trailers, etc...that were left behind when the area was cleared due to the Meeks Table Fire.

Time: Daily, 10 am to 4 pm.

Locations:

1500 Road at the 199 junction for access to camps on the 1500 road system. T14N, R14E, section 7.

1600 Road (Clover Springs Rd.) at the 1601 junction for access to camps up the 1600 road past that point. T16N, R15E, section 30.

1600 Road (Clover Springs Rd.) at the 1706 junction for access to camps down to and including access into the 1605 Road. T16N, R14E, section 6.

Guidelines:

- A limited number of USFS employees will be on site to escort members of the public to camp sites for retrieval of camp equipment, trailers, etc...
- USFS employees will then provide escort back out of the closed road to the original entry location.
- Entry will only be allowed with escort.
- Retrieval of gear must be performed in brief manner.
- Only retrieval of gear that is present in camp will be allowed.
- Hiking to retrieve tree stands, trail cameras or other gear will **not** be allowed.
- Access is only allowed to retrieve gear. Taking gear to a camp or setting up a camp is not allowed.
- Hunting or taking of game will not be allowed while being escorted by USFS employees.
- The Road Closure Order remains in place and anyone that does not follow the above guidelines or is hostile towards USFS employees may still be ticketed.

The US Forest Service reserves the right to terminate this process at any time should the fire conditions change.
