Packer Creek Fire
Emergency Road, Trail and Area Closure

PROHIBITIONS: Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area, roads and trails as described in this order, all within the Pinedale Ranger District, Bridger-Teton National Forest until further notice:

1. Going into or being upon the fire area as described below and depicted on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.53(e)
2. Being on any closed trail in the area described below. 36 CFR 261.55(a)
3. Being on any closed road in the area described below. 36 CFR 261.54(a)

EXEMPTIONS: Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED: The area closure includes all National Forest System Lands within the following perimeter: from the Bridger-Teton National Forest Boundary (Forest Boundary) at Forest Service Road 609 known as the Packer/Miner Road northerly and easterly along the Forest Boundary to the hydrographic divide between Rock Creek and Ole Cabin Creek/Big Twin Creek then northerly and westerly along this divide to the District boundary between Big Piney Ranger District and Pinedale Ranger District, then southerly along this boundary to Highway 189/191, then east along the highway to the Forest Boundary and easterly and northerly along the Forest Boundary to the point of beginning.

Roads and trails within the area that are closed to public use include:

The entire length of Forest Development Roads 607, 608, and 609.

The entire length of trail number 7153(Big Twin/Rock Creek). Portions of trail number 7154 (Sawmill Park Trail) and 2126 (Jack Creek Trail) from the hydrographic divide between Rock Creek and Big Twin Creek to the Pinedale Ranger District Boundary at the head of Jack Creek.


The above-described area is within the proclaimed and administrative boundaries of the Pinedale Ranger District, Bridger-Teton National Forest, Sublette County, Wyoming.

PURPOSE: This closure is necessary to provide protection to forest visitors from the current fire safety hazards associated with the Packer Creek Fire.


IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for individuals or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571 (b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
4. This Order supersedes any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order in the above-described area.
