

## Hunter Peak Fire – Monday afternoon update – 8/15/16

While smoke did not clear in the Clark River Basin as rapidly as expected this morning,



winds from the east-southeast did materialize around noon near the fire (with local canyon variations), clearing up the lower levels. Cumulus cloud build up over the fire helped pushed a smoke plume the opposite direction, which was likely visible looking north from Cody.



Air quality levels for the last 24 hours (5 pm to 5 pm) at Painter Outpost averaged 50 ug/m<sup>3</sup>, putting the area into a health category of Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups. People with respiratory or heart disease, the elderly and children should limit prolonged exertion under these conditions.
